The conference called Hydrological Days, organized alternately by the Slovak Committee for Hydrology and the Czech National Committee for Hydrology, has been held at 5-year intervals since 1980. In Slovakia, the conference was previously held in 1985 at Zemplínska Šírava, 1996 in Stará Lesná, and 2005 and 2015 in Bratislava. The most recent conference took place in 2021 in Brno. The conferences have always been organized in close cooperation with leading hydrological and water management institutions in Slovakia and the Czech Republic. The organizers believe that this year's joint scientific event will contribute to the tradition of serious, competent, and systematic approach to hydrology and its application in modern practice, which affects society as a whole.

Publication Outputs

1. Before the event, an electronic **Proceedings of Reviewed Abstracts** will be published in Slovak or Czech with simultaneous translation into English, available on the conference website.
2. Authors of selected papers will be invited by the scientific committee to prepare chapters in Czech and Slovak after the conference, which will be compiled into an electronic reviewed book (monograph) titled **Czech and Slovak Hydrology at the Beginning of the 21st Century**. It will be published on the website of the Institute of Hydrology SAS, v. v. i.
3. Authors will have the opportunity to publish papers in the following journals (as of February 24, 2026), by agreement with the organizing committee:
 - **Vodohospodársky spravodajca** (issue 9/10, 7-8 articles to be published in September 2026), in Slovak and Czech - confirmed
 - **Meteorologický časopis** (issues 2/2026 and 1/2027, 5 articles per issue), in Slovak, Czech and English
 - **Acta Hydrologica Slovaca** (issue 2/2026, 10-15 articles) (Scopus), in English
 - **Vodohospodárské technicko-ekonomické informácie** (Scopus)
 - **Journal of Hydrology and Hydromechanics** (CC, WOS), in English
